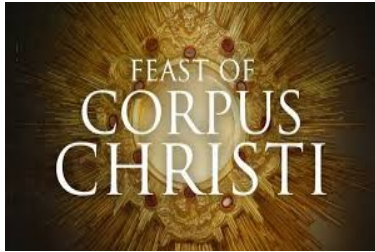

I desire mercy - not sacrifice

When Jesus saw Matthew sitting at his tax office - no doubt counting his day's profit - Jesus spoke only two words - "**follow me**". Those two words changed Matthew from a self-serving profiteer to a God-serving apostle who would bring the treasures of God's kingdom to the poor and needy. When the Pharisees challenged Jesus' unorthodox behavior in eating with public sinners, Jesus' defense was quite simple. “A doctor doesn't need to visit healthy people; instead he goes to those who are sick.” Jesus likewise sought out those in the greatest need. A true physician seeks healing of the whole person - body, mind and spirit. Jesus came as the divine physician and good shepherd to care for His people and to restore them to wholeness of life. The orthodox were so preoccupied with their own practice of religion that they neglected to help the very people who needed spiritual care. Their religion was selfish because they didn't want to have anything to do with people not like themselves.

Jesus stated His mission in unequivocal terms: *I came not to call the righteous, but to call sinners.* Ironically the orthodox were as needy as those they despised. *All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God* (Romans 3:23).

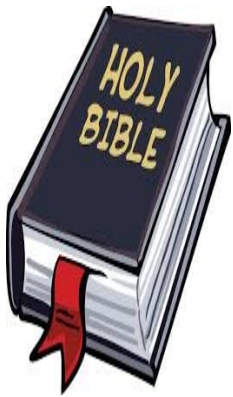

FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI

- ◆ The Feast of Corpus Christi originated in 1246 when **Robert de Torote, Bishop of Liège**, ordered the festival celebrated in his diocese. He was persuaded to initiate the feast by St. Juliana, prioress of Mont Cornillon near Liège (1222–58), who had experienced a vision.
- ◆ This year marks the 760th celebration of the **Feast of Corpus Christi** (Latin for “**Body of Christ**”) – also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.
- ◆ **Corpus Christi** is primarily celebrated by the **Roman Catholic Church** but it is also **included in the calendar of some Anglican churches**. The city of Corpus Christi, in Texas, was named after the day.
- ◆ In some countries in the world, Catholic churches still celebrate the festival, not only with a Mass, but also with a procession that carries the consecrated wafer through the streets as a **public statement** that the **sacrifice of Christ was for the salvation of the whole world**.
- ◆ Some of the Corpus Christi symbols include **Bread and Wine (Plate and Chalice)**, **a bunch of grapes, vine, peacock feeding on grapes and any symbol of the Eucharist**.
